# Appendix 5 Composers Copland Met Represented in the Fleisher Collection

Whereas Copland was unimpressed with some of music he encountered and studied in Latin America, others, such as Gilbert Chase, Carleton Sprague Smith, and Lazare Saminsky, found great value in it. After his "South American fishing trip," Nicolas Slonimsky brought back to the United States numerous orchestral scores, including some by composers Copland met.
